## What's Included?

4-8 participants

5 hours of instruction, including time for everyone to practice shooting using the hosts children as models.

Camera 101 booklet

Snacks and drinks

As the host you receive high resolution copies of any images that I take of your children during the workshop.

Your workshop experience includes 5 hours of small group instruction and practical application of the techniques that we will learn about for yourself and 3- 7 of your friends.

We will start the day learning about basic camera technique. This part of the day is our “classroom” portion of the workshop. I will walk you through all the basics of exposure, aperture, shutter, speed and more. I will basically walk you through what all of the buttons and dials on your camera really do and how to use them.

Workshops are held in your home. (yes, I travel to you!)

When: choose a day that is convenient to you :)

Please note that Saturdays and Sundays (if available) fill quickly and should be reserved well in advance.

Duration & start time: to allow me to share with you all of my hints and tips, as well as giving you time to practice, we'll need around 4-5 hours - you choose a time that works for you and your friends :)

Bring your DSLR camera, a notebook and yourself.

Cost: \$75 per person. As the host of the workshop, you only pay \$50.

Gift vouchers are valid for use for 12 months from date of purchase.

## FAQs

Can I still host/attend if I don't have a DSLR camera?

This workshop is meant for mom's who want to learn to use their DSLR cameras to take better images of their children in their homes. You can choose to attend without a DSLR, but there may be things that we are learning about or practicing that your camera will not be able to do if you have a point and shoot which can be frustrating. I do have one entry level DSLR with two lenses available for use for a \$25 rental fee.

Is there a minimum and maximum number of people who can attend a workshop?

We need a minimum of 4 people and there is a maximum of 8 people per workshop, to allow you to get enough 1-1 time with me.

What if I don't have children of my own? Can I still attend?

You are welcome to attend a workshop even if you don't have children of your own. If you would like to host a workshop and you do not have children, arrange to have one of your friends bring their children so that we will have someone to use as models.

Can my friends bring their children over for the workshop?

Unfortunately, too many kids in the kitchen make the cooks crazy! Unless you do not have children of your own (see above) please ask your friends to leave their children at home. This will dramatically cut down on confusion and let us use our time most effectively.

Do I need a baby sitter for the workshop?

Since the first portion of our workshop focuses on classroom style learning it is helpful to have a willing spouse or baby sitter to watch the children for the first part of the workshop. I want you to be fully engaged in our learning, not running after little ones!

This sounds like it would be a great gift!

Not a question, per se, but you are absolutely right! You can purchase a certificate for your loved one to host a workshop and then all they need to do is recruit some friends and pick a date.
